Course Descriptions

A Member's Guide to Missions (PT524): The Great Commission is the church's responsibility and all believers are to be engaged in carrying it out. This class focuses on those who serve as senders rather than as sent ones. If we are to serve well as senders we need to understand the mission, how the local assembly is involved in fulfilling that mission, and also the role that individual church members play in advancing the mission of Jesus Christ.

Hosea-Zephaniah (OT134): This course will be a study of the message of Hosea-Zephaniah. Emphasis will be given to both the prophets' historical setting and their contribution to biblical theology. The goal is for the student to be familiar with the prophets' writings and better equipped to apply their message today.

Theology of Spiritual Transformation (ST314): This course will study the key NT passages related to the spiritual transformation of believers with the goal of developing a solid doctrinal framework that informs and directs personal spiritual growth as well as discipleship and counseling ministry.

John's Gospel (NT206): This course is an exposition of the Gospel of John. Emphasis will be given to the purpose of the book, interpretive issues, and application.
